

### Empowered for Exploits

Romans 8:1-14; Acts 1:4-8

**Memory Verse:** *“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”* (Acts 1:8).

#### Introduction

The Christian life is a journey filled with extraordinary possibilities, yet many struggle under the weight of sin and the pressures of an ungodly world. The world is marked by moral decay, and even believers often find themselves wrestling with the challenge of living above sin. Left to human strength alone, victory over sin and a truly victorious Christian life remain impossible.

However, God has not called us to strive in our ability. He has provided the Holy Spirit as our divine enabler. If your heart desires to live a life that honors God, it can only be through the power of the Spirit. The first and greatest exploit of the Spirit's empowerment is the ability to live a holy life—walking in righteousness despite the world's corruption. Romans 8:11 reminds us of a profound truth: “But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.” This means the same power that resurrected Christ is at work in us, not just for survival but for transformation—enabling us to break free from sin, walk in holiness, and live in alignment with God's will. This is the foundation of an empowered life.
